

[Education: Number of schools, number of students, number of staff engaged (including academic and administrative staff); school preparation of academic staff; number of students according to distance traveled to school; school infrastructure including information related to water, heating, sewerage access, facility condition, inventory status, number of classrooms, possession of scientific or research cabinets; the average grade of students in schools, the average of points in the achievement test; the extent of pre-primary education, and the number of students, the extent of primary education and the number of students, the extent of secondary education and the number of students, the number of students in the municipality and trends; number of illiterates trend and their place in the population of the municipality, number of teachers (teacher / student ratio and teacher / resident ratio).]

[Infrastructure: the length in kilometers of asphalt roads that cross the municipality; Km road / Km² surface ratio; length of paved roads (preferably by type, with gravel, soil, stone, etc.); Km road / Km² surface ratio; the length of the railway road that crosses the municipality and its end points; Electricity supply (good, sufficient, poor); telecommunication extension (good, sufficient, poor), length of fecal, atmospheric sewerage, sidewalks, public lighting and water supply, urban planning, parks and squares, roads, sidewalks, public transport, public parking, public lighting, supply water, sewage, waste collection, waste disposal, etc. Waste management; public services.]

[Health and Social Welfare: number of family members who have benefited from the social assistance scheme, basic old-age pensions, war veterans pension scheme, age contributory pensions, number of families who have benefited from the social assistance, pension scheme for families with children of martyrs and war invalids, occupational

disability pensions, pensions of persons with disabilities, number of health facilities, their condition, number of visits, number of services provided, frequency of services by years.]

[Agriculture and Rural Development: Area planted for each agricultural crop, number of farmers, number of agricultural holdings, land categorization, pasture area; number of registered businesses, number of active businesses, turnover value per sector and subsector, number of employees per sector and sub-sectors, export value, private sector challenges.]
